This logging plan has been submitted to CDF by the YMCA San Francisco, owners of Camp Jones Gulch (aka Science Camp/Outdoor Ed.), to log 733 acres of the 907 acre property, cutting 40% of redwood and fir trees 18 inches in diameter or larger, "hazard" trees, and trees damaged during logging. The permit would be in perpetuity (forever) and could be changed without public input. The old growth redwoods (40+ inches) provide nesting habitat for endangered marbled murrelets that are at risk. The proposed logging would result in ten truckloads per day for 8-10 weeks, winter harvesting, impacts to local creeks, wildlife, and communities.

POINTS TO MAKE

To the YMCA: This NTMP plan should be withdrawn. This plan, in perpetuity, is inappropriate for the community, creeks, wildlife, etc.!
To CDF: This plan should be denied and list some of the reasons why you believe that, using info. from the plan (or paragraph above).
