



# RALLY FOR COYOTE VALLEY

**January 22 | 12:00-1:30 pm**

**West Plaza, Outside of San Jose City Hall**

Coyote Valley — the wetlands, open space, and farmland just south of urban San Jose — has been threatened by industrial sprawl for too long. 5,000 people have signed the petition calling for the protection of Coyote Valley. On Tuesday, January 22 at City Hall, we are holding a rally for the protection of this regional treasure.

On that Tuesday, the San Jose City Council is bringing the future of North Coyote Valley to a special study session. Now is the time to stand together for Coyote Valley as the council considers public purchase of land with up to \$50 million of proceeds generated by Measure T bond funding. We will rally outside of City Hall and walk into council chambers together at 1:30pm and stand together for the first 20 minutes of the session.
